


Idyllic Location



Since 1987, the management of Wrexham Care Centre has striven to offer a highly professional care service for the elderly, with a personal touch. Wrexham Care Centre caters for the elderly (male and female) with severe and enduring mental health problems, including organic and functional disorders.



24 hour special nursing care

Our home provides accommodation for up to 35 people. The service includes 24 hours special psychiatric nursing care, provided by Registered Mental Nurses and Registered General Nurses with extensive experience in caring for persons with cognitive difficulties and challenging behaviour specialist skills, include cognitive and behaviour therapy risk assessment and management, infection control and management of challenging behaviour. As a specialist in dementia care, the service and currently does provide for some residents under age 65 living with pre-senile dementia.
